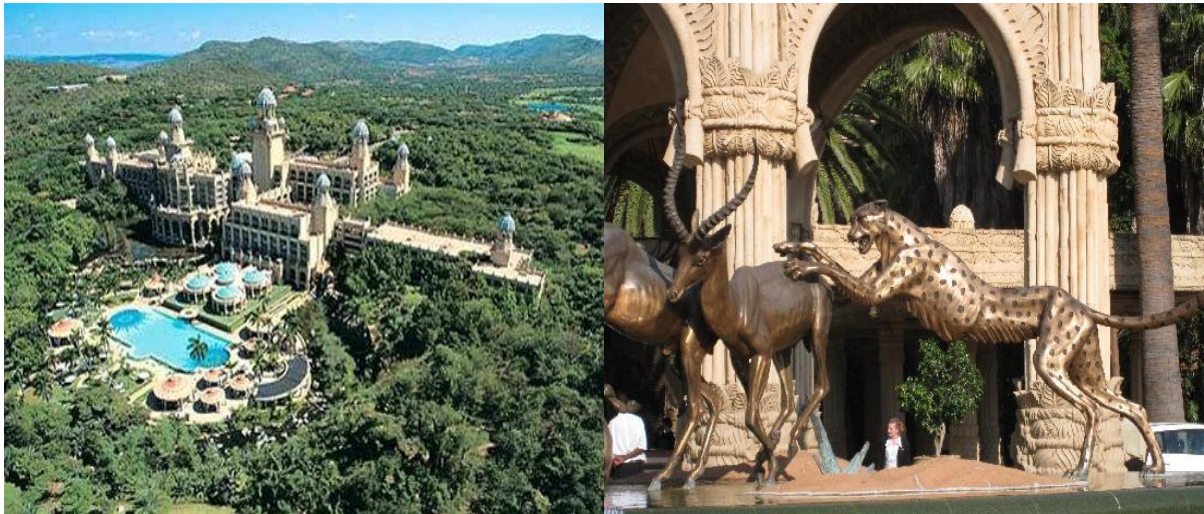

Built in an extinct volcanic crater, this immaculate golfing paradise conforms to the stringent US PGA specifications and was recently named South Africa's Best Golf Course in the World Golf Awards 2015. It is also home to the annual Nedbank Golf Challenge which plays host to some of the world's golfing legends.

When construction of the Sun City Resort began in 1978, the decision was taken to build a golf course that would rival the best in the world. Today, in spite of stiff competition, the Gary Player Country Club is deservedly ranked as one of the most prestigious golf courses on the African continent.

golfing heritage, The Links has hosted some of the most prestigious tournaments in the world, including the Presidents Cup (2003), the SA Open (2005) and the 2012 Volvo Golf Champions European Tour. Inspired by the famous links courses of the British Isles, The Links is considered a masterpiece and plays host to a range of global golfing legends including John Bland, Justin Rose, Retief Goosen, Branden Grace and Ernie Els

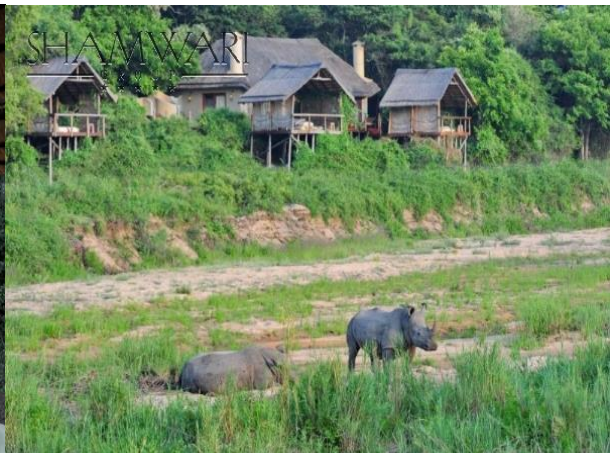

That said, hazards at Leopards Creek certainly take on a new meaning with sightings of crocodile, hippo, antelope, buffalo and elephant being all too common. A dream for the safari enthusiast!

For every entry into South Africa from the USA or other African countries, the visitor is required to have 2 blank pages (next to each other) in his/her passport. Without this, entry will be denied. These must be visa pages in the passport. The amendment pages at the end of the US passport cannot be

used as these are only for use by US officials. On arrival, the visitor should request a 90 day visa which will allow them to go in and out of the country on the same visa

In addition, 1 clean page is needed for a visa or entry stamp into other African Countries

Passport must be valid at least six months beyond the intended period of stay in South Africa

Internal air prices are only an indication on the day of quoting and not guaranteed until paid in full

BANK FEES:

If paying via a wire transfer, clients' should check with their bank to ascertain if the funds are paid directly into Africapass's Standard Bank account. Often an intermediary Bank is involved and an additional fee is charged

When paying by credit card, the credit card company works on an exchange rate that is normally higher than the quoted rate for that day. (can be up to 10% more). Any short payment due to currency fluctuations/rate of exchange must be paid in full prior to arrival date

CANCELLATIONS:
