The seven night tour will feature the best St. Andrews courses, including two Open Championship venues - The Old Course and Carnoustie Championship Links. Handicap limits for both courses are 24 for men and 36 for women. Note the starters at check-in for play might ask for proof of handicap so bring along your USGA Ghin card or other proof. Caddies are not required at any of the scheduled courses, however, we recommend caddies on the Old Course and Carnoustie. Caddy fees are £40 plus a tip so expect to pay \$80 per bag. Caddies carry one bag. Lodging is at David Russell Apartments a University of St. Andrews residence, located a short walk into town. See lodging notes on the next page. St. Andrews is a bustling, summer community, take time to walk around the "Auld Toon" visit its many historical sites and enjoy its many attractions, especially the Cathedral ruins where Scotland's legendary golfers are buried. Enjoy the town's many fine restaurants and pubs many of which entertained our great Open Champions.

Lodging David Russell Hall

Lodging is at the University of St. Andrews David Russell Apartments with the option of single rooms or sharing a twin bedded room. The residence offers 3-star bed and breakfast accommodations in modern en-suite bedrooms and friendly service. David Russell Apartments are less than a ten minute walk from the historic centre of St Andrews, and a half-mile from the famous Old Course. Free car-parking is available for guests so once you arrive you can park your car and then explore the town on foot. It is the ideal base for exploring St Andrews, playing golf on the famous links courses and for discovering the summer attractions of Kingdom of Fife. All bedrooms feature an en-suite shower room, a double bed, a television and tea and coffee making facilities. A full Scottish breakfast is served from 07:30 to 09:30 each morning in the residence dining room, and a full service pub is located in the foyer for adult refreshment.

St Andrews Links

The town of St. Andrews, Fife, is regarded as the "home of golf." It has one of the oldest courses in the world, where the game has been played since the 15th century. Today there are seven golf courses; the Balgove, Strathtyrum, Eden, Jubilee and New, plus the Old Course, which is widely considered one of the finest, and certainly one of the best known courses in the world. The seventh course Castle Course, sited on the cliffs a mile to the east of St Andrews and designed by the architect David McLay Kidd, opened in June 2008. The courses of St Andrews Links are owned by the local authorities and operated by St Andrews Links Trust, a charitable organization. St Andrews is also home to the Royal and Ancient Golf Club of St. Andrews, one of the most prestigious golf clubs and until 2004 one of the two rule making authorities of golf (in that year, the Royal and Ancient Club passed on its rulemaking authority to an off-shoot organization, The R&A).


St. Andrews History

Royal Ancient Game of golf as it grew to dominate a town whose history reaches back to the Bronze age and Roman legionaries. Known as the ecclesiastical heart of the Roman Church in Scotland, it was ruled by Bishops and visited for centuries by Kings and Queens. Along with golfing the great links, participants will visit St. Andrews historical sites including the ruins of the 12 century Cathedral, where the great champions of golf, Auld Tom Morris and son Tom Jr., winner of five Open Championships lie among the great Bishops. St. Rules Tower within the Cathedral grounds, is said to have guarded the relics of St. Andrews the patron saint of Scotland, and the nearby Castle, a fortification reaching out of the sea, existed as far back as 700BC.
