

Parent-Child Golf Tour St. Andrews, Scotland July 18 to 25, 2021 An historical golf adventure for parents or grandparents to travel with children or grandchildren, boys or girls

### The Schedule

Sun. July 18: Depart USA, for Edinburgh, Scotland (overnight flight).

**Mon. July 19**: Arrive Edinburgh International Airport, Scotland. Transfer by private coach or mini-van to St. Andrews, check-in the Agnes Blackadder Hall, University of St. Andrews. After lunch at the Eden clubhouse, warm-up on the Links driving range. Play a practice round on the Eden Course. Welcome to St. Andrews dinner at the New Links Clubhouse.

**Tues. July 20:** Breakfast at Agnes Blackadder Hall. Practice round parent-child tournament on the Jubilee, Eden or New Course. An afternoon historic tour of St. Andrews, including a pilgrimage to the Cathedral ruins, the Tom Morris family gravesite, the Castle and the Links Trust Golf Museum. An evening golf-clinic at the Links Driving Range.

Wed. July 21: Breakfast Agnes Blackadder Hall. Play the first round of the parent- child tournament on the Jubilee, Eden or New Course. An afternoon golf-clinic at the Links driving range.

**Thus. July 22**: Breakfast at Agnes Blackadder Hall. A morning departure for a visit to Scotland's capital city, Edinburgh. Start with a historic City tour with guide, including Holyrood Palace and the Edinburgh Castle, Leith and the Royal Yacht, dinner at the King's Wark in Leith

**Fri. July 23**: Breakfast at Agnes Blackadder Hall. Play the second round of the parent-child tournament on the Castle Course. Travel along the Neuk of Fife to visit the Falkland Palace, picturesque Crail Harbor and perhaps dinner at Anstruther's award winning chip, "Best in Britain" fish and chip shop. An evening clinic at the Links Driving Range.

**Sat. July 24**: Breakfast at Agnes Blackadder Hall. Play the final round of the parent-child golf tournament at Kingsbarns Golf Club, the latest addition to St. Andrews golf legacy. Final evening awards dinner at the New Links Clubhouse.

Sun July 25: Check-out Agnes Blackadder Hall return to Edinburgh International Airport for the journey home.

Is your tour Escorts who will conduct clinics and play with participants throughout the tour. An informal 54-hole parent-child best ball event will be played over three of the courses, with daily prizes and 54 hole awards. Young golfers should have golfing experience and knowledge of basic golf rules and golf etiquette.

St. Andrews Old Course: For golfers interested in playing the Old Course, we will place names in the daily ballot two days before the proposed day of play. If successful on any event day, Old Course scores will count towards the 54-hole event total. Successful Old Course ballot golfers are expected to pay Old Course fee of £195 per golfer (\$268) directly to the starter and to produce an official handicap record. Handicap limits are 24 for men and 36 for women. Please make sure you bring along your official state handicap card or a certificate from your golf professional stating your handicap. Caddies are available at all the courses but need to be booked in advance. Golfers can carry their own bags or hire trolleys (Trolleys are allowed on the Old Course only after 12.00 PM)

This is an opportunity for fathers, grandfathers, mothers and grandmothers to play the famous St. Andrews links together with their children, grandchildren, boys and girls, and learn the history of the Royal Ancient Game of golf as it grew to dominate a town whose history reaches back to the Bronze age and Roman legionaries. Known as the ecclesiastical heart of the Roman Church in Scotland, it was ruled by Bishops and visited for centuries by Kings and Queens. Along with golfing the great links, participants will visit St. Andrews historical sites including the ruins of the 12 century Cathedral, where the great champions of golf, Auld Tom Morris and son Tom Jr., winner of five Open Championships lie among the great Bishops. St. Rules Tower within the Cathedral grounds, is said to have guarded the relics of St. Andrews the patron saint of Scotland, and the nearby Castle, a fortification reaching out of the sea, existed as far back as 700BC. The British Golf Museum, founded in 1990, which contains a huge collection of documents and the implements related to the history of golf and the foundation of St. Andrews as the birthplace of golf dating back to the 1400s. Falkland Palace summer home of Mary Queen of Scots and a grand tour of Edinburgh, Scotland Capital city are other highlights of an historic golf tour.


## Lodging

Parent-child lodging is at the University of St. Andrews Agnes Blackadder Hall with the option of single rooms or sharing a twin bedded room. The residence offers 3-star bed and breakfast accommodations in modern en-suite bedrooms and friendly service. Agnes Blackadder Hall is located just a few hundred yards from the world famous golf courses and less than a ten minute walk from the historic centre of St Andrews. Free carparking is available for guests so once you arrive you can park your car and then explore the town on foot. It is the ideal base for exploring St Andrews, playing golf on the famous links courses and for discovering the summer attractions of Kingdom of Fife. All bedrooms feature an en-suite shower room, a double bed, a television and tea and coffee making facilities. A full Scottish breakfast is served from 07:30 to 09:30 each morning in the residence dining room, and a full service pub is located in the foyer for adult refreshment. During the week, we will conduct an informal, handicap, stableford Parent Child team tournament with rounds as specified on the schedule. Participants playing the Old Course under the ballot process, will use their score points from the old course round towards the event.

### St Andrews Links

The town of St. Andrews, Fife, is regarded as the "home of golf." It has one of the oldest courses in the world, where the game has been played since the 15th century. Today there are seven golf courses; the Balgove, Strathtyrum, Eden, Jubilee and New, plus the Old Course, which is widely considered one of the finest, and certainly one of the best known courses in the world. The seventh course Castle Course, sited on the cliffs a mile to the east of St Andrews and designed by the architect David McLay Kidd, opened in June 2008. The courses of St Andrews Links are owned by the local authorities and operated by St Andrews Links Trust, a charitable organization. St Andrews is also home to the Royal and Ancient Golf Club of St. Andrews, one of the most prestigious golf clubs and until 2004 one of the two rule making authorities of golf (in that year, the Royal and Ancient Club passed on its rulemaking authority to an offshoot organization, The R&A).
